Resolution

Sub:- Amendment in the internship policy for the students of Government Engineering Colleges run under the Department of Science, Technology and Technical Education.

Currently, 38 government engineering colleges operate under the Department of Science, Technology and Technical Education. These institutions offer both general disciplines and the latest and emerging engineering courses. Various decisions have been taken to ensure quality engineering education and regulate academic sessions. In this regard, the Bihar Engineering University was established to offer degree-level engineering courses. Bihar Engineering University has updated curricula in various disciplines, and related action is ongoing. The department has implemented various innovative interventions at the Bihar Engineering University level to enhance the skills of students studying in government engineering colleges and equip them with industry demands. Students should not only receive theoretical advancement but also develop their skills at the practical and applied level. A well-thought-out policy is needed to achieve this.

2. In view of the above, an internship policy has been prepared by the Department of Science, Technology and Technical Education for skill development of students pursuing B.Tech course in Government Engineering Colleges.
3. The objective of the proposed Internship Policy is to provide opportunities to the students studying in Government Engineering Colleges as interns to enhance their practical knowledge of the subject and to make them efficient for employment in Government and private sectors.
4. All students pursuing the B.Tech. (four-year) program at government engineering colleges will be eligible for the internship policy. The third and fifth semesters offer four and six-week internships, respectively. The seventh semester offers a four to six week internship in a physical classroom. All interested seventh-semester students will be offered internship opportunities on a priority basis in state government run projects. For this purpose, the department will develop an online portal, which will contain information on the names of projects being run by departments, corporations, boards, and societies, as well as the expected number of students seeking internships.
5. Various departments under the Government of Bihar and state funded corporations, boards, societies, etc. are implementing major developmental projects. Involving students directly in these projects and at the implementation site will enhance their knowledge and skills, thereby creating a skilled and efficient technical workforce in the state and ensuring their participation in the economic development of the entire state. Arrangements for internships will be made in projects of the corporations,



boards, and societies under the administrative control of the VINAM and those corporations, boards, and societies that implement developmental projects.

6. All the students doing 4-6 weeks of offline internship in the seventh semester by the Department of Science, Technology and Technical Education will be given an amount of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand rupees) only as incentive and for preparing the project, on which an expenditure of Rs. 14,00,00,000/- (Fourteen Crore rupees) only is estimated per year. This amount will be transferred online to the bank account of the students after they complete the internship and submit the project report and after the evaluation by the committee formed at the institute level.

7. Based on the projects being conducted in various departments/corporations/boards/societies, the number of students for internship in engineering courses branch wise will be determined every year in coordination with the Department of Science, Technology and Technical Education and the concerned department/corporation/board/society.

8. Every year, the scheme will be approved by the competent authority as determined by the Finance Department's Resolution-3758, dated-31.05.2017 (amended from time to time) as per the cost of the scheme.

9. The expenditure of the above amount will be made from the amount provided under State Scheme Budget Major Head 2203 Technical Education, Sub Major Head -00-Minor Head -112- Engineering Technical Colleges and Institutes, Sub Head 0101- Undergraduate/Postgraduate Courses (Bill Code-43-2203001120101) under Demand No. 43 in the financial year 2023-24.

10. After due consideration, the State Government has decided to approve the internship policy for students of the State Engineering Colleges operated under the Department of Science, Technology and Technical Education. The approved internship policy for the State Engineering Colleges is attached as Annexure-1.

11. This resolution is being issued with the consent of the Internal Financial Advisor in light of the decision taken under item number 02 in the meeting of the Council of Ministers held on 06.02.2024. The consent of the Internal Financial Advisor is obtained on, page 15/T of file No. V.P. & T.S. (VI) -02/2024.

12. The earlier issued Resolution No. 721 dated 16.02.2024 shall be deemed to be amended to this extent.

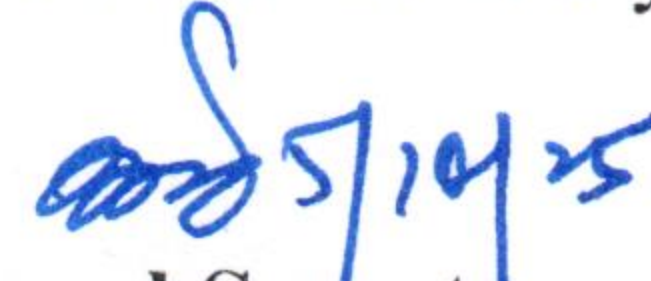
